Launch packages for schools and clubs can easily be tailored to your needs as well, so just get in touch.











Official Court Size

Top Tip ADAPT YOUR WALL!

We know the official court size is pretty big. If you can't fit one in, don't worry! Just adapt to the space you have.
That's the beauty of Wallball!

Any Wall

Cost: £0

That's right. Any wall. Your door, the garage, the wall at school. Flip your table on its side, take down that "no ball games allowed" sign. Get going immediately.

When we say "any wall", we mean it!

DIY Court

Cost: ~£5

Get going right away with a DIY Court. All you need is a wall and you're good to go. Get some chalk, paint or, like in this photo, masking tape.

Here we've marked a court on the wall and the floor with tape. These ladies marked the court in 2 minutes flat.

You'll get the odd uneven bounce but that doesn't matter. You'll often adapt these courts to the space you have available. They don't need to be full size!

Main Features:

Essentially free

Adapt the size to the space you've got available

What you need: tape/chalk/paint

Great for the playground

Great for a temporary court

Great for getting started



Upgrade your DIY court?



Painted Court

Cost: ~£30

Fancy making that outdoor wall look a bit more pro? Then turn temporary into permanent with some paint.

You can even use a white wall like this as a blank canvas for arty kids to do their own murals on, or just keep it a solid colour for awesome photos!

Main Features:

Very cheap

Looks more official and demarcates it from other games

What you need: a 5L tin of masonry paint

Great for playgrounds

A potentially awesome street-art project

Super easy!



Existing smooth wall?



Cost: ~£30

If you have an existing smooth wall, either outdoors or indoors, you can mark the court up with line marking tape or painted lines.

Line Marked Court

The closer the court gets to a regulation size, the more options are opened up in terms of hosting competitions and clubs, etc.

Skirting board may be an issue. To start with you can play over it, but later ideally you'll want to remove the skirting board and create a crisp angle between the wall and the floor.

Main Features:

Very cheap

High quality court – either indoors or outdoors

What you need: paint or 2 rolls of line marking tape

Great for schools and clubs

Just lines = non-obstructive when not in use.

Great for all levels of the game through to top competition



Existing rough wall?



Indoor Panel Court

Cost: starts ~£800 per court + labour

If you want to build a top quality court on a slightly uneven breeze-block or brick wall, then you can simply create a frame, screw that to the wall and then screw panels on top of that for a nice flat playing surface.

If an individual panel get damaged it can easily be replaced. They can also be decorated easily.

2 rows of 5 sheets of wood = the exact dimensions of a court.

Main Features:

Relatively low cost

High quality

What you need: 10 sheets 12mm ply/MDF + frame + tape

Great for sports halls and community centres

Safe and non-obstructive

Easily repaired and decorated



MUGA/Outdoor Area



Outdoor Court

Cost: starts ~£1500 per court + labour

MUGAs and are great areas for Wallball. The floors are already there and you just build onto the existing fence. Walls are extremely versatile. When not being used for Wallball they can used as a tennis practice wall, target-practice football goal, billboard, etc.

As this is outdoors you should use marine plywood or a plastic composite sheet. Courts like the one on the left can also be printed with an anti-graffiti vinyl for awesome looking designs.

Main Features:

Relatively low cost for an outdoor sport.

Looks absolutely outstanding!

What you need: weatherproof materials, paint

Great for the communities and schools

Perfect for community engagement

Think of these as giant billboards – great for branding!



On the move or doing a demo?



Portable Court

Cost: ~£1000-5000 (size dependent)

Portable courts are great for running demos, adding a temporary court to a venue/competition or permanent court that gets stored away after use.

The picture on the left is a full size court, but portable courts can be much smaller, depending on needs.

They are very cost-effective and excellent for for pop up demos, conferences and exhibition matches at cool events.

Main Features:

Very versatile

Great for demonstrating the sport in a variety of spaces

Requires storage & construction each time

Excellent high-impact branding

Highly cost-effective

Useful for adding additional courts to an event as well



Standalone outdoor court – option 1



Breeze block & plaster

Cost: ~£8000 per court

Breeze block walls with a strong foundation and a plaster finish to smooth the surface has been a popular choice for walls in Europe.

Walls are solid and make a statement. They are fantastic for playing on and can also be used for high-impact branding space.

Thye are easily decorated and great for competition. Strong plaster may need repairing over time (years).

As always, walls can be used for other activities.

Great for outdoor competition



Concrete Court

Cost: ~£15,000 for 2 courts

Wallball has its root in New York City streetculture. New York has over 2,500 courts across the city, free to use all day long by anyone.

The courts are part of the culture now and provide free activity and exercise for anyone, regardless of background.

The courts are weatherproof concrete slabs with strong foundations underground. Again the courts are versatile and can be used for other activities. They can also be decorated.

Main Features:

Tried and tested over 2,500 times

Permanent

1 court = actually 2 courts. Front and back



Shipping Container Court

Cost: ~£9000 for 2 courts

We think this could be the future. 2 x 20ft shipping containers stacked on top of each other = a full size regulation Wallball court. Actually it's two Wallball courts as you can use the front and the back.

The containers will require the sides to panelled to make the walls smooth.

You'll also have loads of indoor space within the containers for storage, an office or even a pop-up cocktail bar!

Main Features:

Trailblazing outdoor court, recycled and inspiring

Relatively low cost. 2 courts for the price of 1

Semi-permanent as they can be moved and transported

Great for parks and outdoor spaces

Indoor secure area for a variety of uses


